Tsum Valley Trek

Trip Overview

Isolated trans-Himalayan valley in close proximity with Tibet, Tsum Valley is as beautiful as it is revered

Tsum valley trekking is a recently opened trekking destination located in trans-Himalayan region of Gorkha District. However, it still falls under restricted area for trekking in Nepal, demanding high permit fees to get there. Tsum Valley is a sacred Himalayan Valley hidden in the wilderness of the Himalayas ringed by Buddha Himal, Himal Chuli, Ganesh Himal and Sringi Himal among others.

The Tsum Valley trek in Manaslu

Tsum Valley is cultural treasure trove housing many ancient monasteries, chortens and mani walls scattered in every corner of this wonderful valley. The myths associated with Buddhism can be heard throughout the monasteries in Tsum Valley. Steps of the great Buddhist Yogi Chyuchin Milarepa and story of Guru Padmasambhava circumnavigating the valley are the popular ones. In fact, Tsum Valley restricts animal sacrifice making it one of the peaceful revered Buddhist Valleys in entire Nepal.

The trek starts at Arughat Bazaar, winds through the peaceful trails of Manaslu Conservation Area Project, and arrives to the valley after several days of walk. Rachen Gompa and Mu Gompa are the interesting monasteries in the valley, where trekkers can witness young monks and nuns learning the principles of Buddhism. Homestay accommodation in the monasteries can be a wonderful experience during the Tsum Valley Trek and the culture that resembles to the Tibetan in closest possible justifies Tsum Valley's closest proximity with Tibet.

Overall, the fascinating trek that spellbinds trekkers with its untouched natural beauty and nomadic cultural aspect makes you fall in love with Nepal. Try it and we assure, this won't be your first trek in Nepal. You will keep on coming.
