Humla Limi Valley Trek

Dreams of witnessing centuries old trans-Himalayan Region of Nepal - Try Limi Valley Trek

When it comes to trek in the remotest corner of the earth, Limi Valley Trek surpasses every trekking holiday that exists in the modern day tourism. The trek of the lifetime, Limi Valley Trek kicks off from the secluded fabled district of Humla in far western region of Nepal. The fun of real trekking is actually on treading the trails, where you get to see very few footprints and our ten-day long Limi Valley Trek stretches very close to Tibetan border via the enchantingly beautiful Limi Valley. The valley dominated by the Bhote Tribe (the descendants of Tibet) is considered the modern day Shangri-La by many trekkers.

Probably Limi Valley is one of the few places on earth, where nature, authentic culture and rich wildlife have prospered in perfect harmony and an opportunity to trek to such a rare place on earth is itself an achievement. Trekking along the ancient Silk route that made trade possible between Tibet and India in the ancient days still has abundant signs of ancient culture. Traders leading the caravans of sheep and mules carrying goods, central Asian faces smoking hookah, women in traditional attires and adorned with mirrors and silver coins and the Bhotes decked with corals and gems can still be found easily in Limi Valley.

Unharmed by the Chinese invasion to Tibet, this particular region in Nepal is a true Tibet, where Tibetan culture can be seen in the best possible authentic form. Not only the cultural aspect, the magnificence of alpine nature also never fades away during this trans-Himalayan trek as mountains like Saipal and Nalakankad never fade away from your sight throughout the trek.

Day 15: Day 15: Trek to Tumkot khola/Muchu Village (3100m) - Camp

Day 16: Day 16: Trek to Salle Khola Via Yalbang Village and Gompa (2500m) - Camp

Day 17: Day 17: Trek to Dharapuri Village Via Kermi (2400m) - Camp

Day 18: Day 18: Trek to Simikot and Explore around Simikot checking Flight to Nepaljung (2950m) - Guest House

Day 19: Day 19: Early Morning Fly to Nepaljung and Fly to Kathmandu (1300m) - Hotel

Day 20: Day 20: Full Free Day Lust and Launa/Relax in Kathmandu (1300m) - Hotel

Day 21: Day 21: Free day and final depart to home or other destination.
