Bardia National Park Tour

Trip Overview

Penetrate the dense woods to the ideal habitats of Royal Bengal Tiger in Bardia National Park

Bardia National park is one of famous spot for Wildlife's activities holiday in Nepal. The national Park located in far west region of Nepal covers the total area of 968 sq km. It is a protected area and it is the second largest home of Royal Bengal Tiger in Nepal. The park also houses many other species of mammals that include one-horned rhino, blackbuck antelopes and wild Asiatic elephants. It is also the home to Gharial crocodiles, birds and Gangetic dolphins in the ideal ecosystem of Karnali River that lies in western border to India. The park offers unique wildlife holidays to see wild animals in the wilds indulged in wild activities.

Compared to Chitwan National Park the wildlife safari in Bardia is expensive because of the remote location, which is not that easily accessible as Chitwan does from other tourist towns of the country. The wildlife activity in Bardia National Park comprises thrilling Elephant Ride deep into the woodlands, Jeep Drive into the possible habitats of Tigers and other wild species, dugout canoe ride for probable sights of aquatic, amphibians and birds species. Moreover, during the stay in the luxury resorts in the middle of jungle, the tharu cultural show is the bonus reward for the travelers.

For those wildlife lovers who prefer tranquil areas and who really want to sight more of wild species, the park is the best destination. Trained guides, welcoming resort staffs and safe accommodation facilities make your wildlife trip in Bardia the most beautiful one compared to any other parks of entire Asia.

Trip Highlights

Day 1: Day 1: Fly to Nepaljung airport and local drive to Ambasa by private jeep about 80km, Transfer to local jungle resort, short brief about the park and program by guide and lunch. Afternoon, village tour to ethical tharu village where you can watch the lifestyle of tharu people. Back resort and meal with private accommodation.

Day 2: Day 2: Morning Weak-up tea, breakfast than elephant ride. An excellent possibilities to crocodile breeding center and tharu cultural museum, back for lunch than Jungle walk where you have chance to see wild animals, small mammals, birds into the tower by nature specialist wildlife local guide. Back hotel and Dinner. Private accommodation.

Day 3: Day 3: Weak up tea, breakfast then most important day begin from tiger tracking and Bird watching most chances to see the Royal Bangal Tiger and a great species of birds found in Bardia. Back for lunch, then jeep safari drive on jungle. Back to resort for dinner with private accommodation.

Day 4: Day 4: Breakfast, Visit to Karnali River for Dolphin sightseeing and birds, back for lunch then departure drive to Nepaljung or onward destination, fly to Kathmandu or onward.
