Lhasa Kailash Tour

Trip Overview

Consider the spiritual journey to Mt. Kailash and Mansarovar lake that caters the highest satisfaction of Hinduism, Buddhism and other magnificence of Himalayan beauty and raw nature. That includes to visit Lhasa city, Mount Kailash Parikrama and Holy bath in Lake Mansarover with Puja and Hawana.

Kailash tour from Lhasa is one of memorable, sacred and high-rewarding pilgrimage yatra in Tibet, that incorporates the fascinating drive and most of the prime highlights of elevated Tibet's east to west by crossing Himalayan Gangas Brahmaputra River. The tour is an adventure based on deluxe hotels, mud house stay and guided by local Tibetan Guide in the Mount Kailash Trek under the Nepalese Supervision.

The Mansarovar Yatra kicks off after the grand rudraabhishek and hawan in great Hindu temple Pashupatinath. Than, you fly over Himalayas Mt. Everest and visit mild sightseeing tour of Tibet's capital Lhasa city. The major landmarks of Lhasa that hold high cultural and religious significance are the prime highlights. The majestic Potala Palace, Jokhang Temple, Deprung and Sera Monastery and the stroll around lively Barkhor Square are the highlights travelers do not like to ignore at Lhasa.

The Tour from Lhasa to Mansarovar Lake and Mt. Kailash

Now a days the holy Kailash Yatra heads out along the Tibetan Highway and arrives at Shigatse. En route, travelers get to savor the magnificence of Himalayan panorama dominated by Mt. Everest and Mt. Shishapangma, and other Trans Himalayan peaks. The highlights of Gyantse, the town lying on the highway unfolds prehistoric Gyantse Dzong and Shigatse caters incredible Buddhist culture at Tashilunpo Monastery. Continuing the ride via Lhatse and Saga, we arrive to the imaginary center of Universe, Lake Mansarovar. The next few days are challenging enough as we go for Kailash circumnavigation along the elevated trails that even includes the high pass Dolma-La 5630m.

The holy dip travelers take in sacred Mansarovar Lake and the strenuous walk to circumambulate Mount Kailash are considered one of the holiest acts as per the Buddhists and Hindu myths. However, the journey is not attached to its religious significance only, the astounding high altitude landscape, the beauty of nature trail caters are simply the best and the rawest travelers get to see in any part of the world.

Important Update: Kailash Charan Sparsh is Banned

As of now, the Kailash Charan Sparsh walk remains closed due to the ongoing ban from Chinese local authority. Pilgrims are still permitted to perform the traditional Kailash Kora (circumambulation) around Mt. Mount Kailash, which is considered equally meritorious. Alternative spiritual practices, are also encouraged to maintain the sanctity of the pilgrimage. And, offer you extra miles pilgrimage path to the Asthapada drive and walk. Asthapada is a part of Kailash Inner Kora where you can get up-close darshan of Kailash Parbat south face and Nandi Parbat.

Day 1: Day 1: Arrival in Kathmandu

Transfer to Hotel Collect your passport for Visa process. Evening Pashupainath Aarati (when time applicable is) Evening dinner Hotel 5 Star on twin share

Day 2: Day 2: Day Temple Tours

After Breakfast, visit Tallest Shiva Tempel as Saga and Doleshwor Dham (head of Ketharnath) and Back to Lunch. Jal Narayan (Sleeping Vishun known as Budhanilkantha) temple tour Back to hotel and rest of the day is free for packing Hotel - Breakfast, Lunch and Dinner

Day 3: Day in Pashupatinath Temple and Tour. (Pashupatinath Temple, Rudraabhishek)

Morning Pashupatinath Darshan and Puja, Hawan and Rudraabhishek by Brahman Back to hotel and rest of the day is free for packing Yatra briefing program with yatra crew and manager Hotel - Breakfast, Lunch and Dinner

Day 4: Day 04: Kathmandu - Lhasa Flight.

After breakfast, drive to Apriprot Fly to Lhasa over Mt. Everest - Best view of Mount Everest and Trans Himalayan Range Drive from Lhasa Gonggar airport to Lhasa City 90km. Check in hotel and to take rest for the acclimatization. Walk and resresh Hotel: Breakfast, Lunch and Dinner

Day 5: Day 05: Lhasa Tour- Tibet. 3656 m.

Day tour in Lhasa Tours to POTALA PALACE, THE JOKHANG and the surrounding BAKHOR market. Hotel: Breakfast, Lunch and Dinner and Guiding service

Day 6: Day 06: Lhasa - Sightsee. 3860 m. 5 hours.

Brekafast and process to drive Drive to Sigatse (the capital of Tibet) Hotel check in The Afternoon is for you to explore the Tibet's second largest city Shigatse for one hour, including the world famous Tashilumpo Monastery. Meal: Breakfast, Lunch and Dinner with guiding service

Day 7: Day 07: Drive to Saga.4650m. 7 hours.

Early morning take breakfast Drive to Saga and meet our Nepali staff/crew they come from Kathmandu. Best view of Mt. Everest, Sishspangma and other Himalayan range. Touch and cross Bramhaputra river Hotel check in Meal prepare by our crew: Breakfast, Lunch and dinner

Day 8: Day 08: Saga - to Mansarovar Lake 4580m - 470 kms.7-8 hours.

Breakfast and prepare for journey to Mansarovar Lake Drive Via Dongba to Mansarovar Lake. Best view of Tibetan Nomad, Himalayas, Bramhaputra River and wildlife Lunch at Mayumla Phadi Cross Mayumla Pass (one of highest pass on the trip) First darshan of Holy Kailash Parbat and Mansarovar Lake from Hor. Take a half parikrama of Mansarovar Lake by Bus and stay night at Tsu Gompa (west side of Mansarovar Lake) Touch the Mansarovar Lake holy water, clean yoru soul and rest at guest house. Meal prepare by our staff: Breakfast, Lunch and Dinner

Day 9: Day 09: Mansarovvar Lake to Darchen 4600m.

Take a Holy bath from the Mansarovar lake water. We will choose the special point to take deep dip in Mansarovar Lake taking bath in cold water. We organize a place for Puja, Hawan and other spiritual activities After puja and hawan free time. Lunch and drive to Darchen. From Mansarovar Lake to Darchen (4600 meters – 40 kilometers.) Get prepare for Kailash Parikrama and walk around. Meal: prepare by our team: Breakfast, Lunch and Dinner

Day 10: Day 10: Kailash Kora trek to Derapuk 4890m.

Drive Darchen to Yamadwar -gate of the god of death) Begin the sacred walk to Dirapuk (4890 meters - 11 kilometers) – Monastery. Very basic dormitory room on sharing basic accommodation available here. Best view of Kailash Parvat North Face. Can by hike more close. Rest and refreshment, our crew serve you hotel soup and drinks. Meal: Breakfast, Lunch and Dinner prepare by our crew.

Day 11: Day 11: Charan Sparsh Walk - Touch Kailash 5590m.

Trek along the Gange River to the Feet of Mt. Kailash Gradually uphill to the charan Sparsh point and downhill walk back to Dirapuk Monastery. Walking distance and time will be aproxmetly 6 to 7 hours and about 12 km. Mistering view of Kailash Parvat form the top to the fit with whole norths face. 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Day 12: Day 12: Domma-La Pass 5630m - Zutulpuk 4800m.

Oen of longest day and the mail goal of Kailash Mansarovar Yatra. After the quick hotel drinks and breakfst start your yatra early morning. The sacred walk goes through Shivatsal. Cross highest pass Dolma-La 5630m Pass above sea leveland Parvati Kunda Trek to Zutulpuk Monastery Takes about 9 to 10 hours walk. Stay at very basic mud house with dormetory beds in Zutulpuk monastery side. Meal: prepared by our yatra staff - Breakfast, Lunch and Dinner with hot drinks

Day 13: Day 13: Zutulpuk - Darchen - Saga (4650m) 8-9 hours. 430km.

Brkeafast in Morning 2 hours final sacred walk to Chogndo nearby Darchen. Take a drive back to Darchen. The holy kailash parikrama and drive back to Saga via Mansarovar Lake to make full kora of Mansarovar. Hotel check in at Saga. Meal: Prepeare by our kitchen crew- Breakfast, Lunch and Dinner

Day 14: Day 14: Drive to Kerung (220km) About 5 to 6 hours. Good Hotel.

After Breakfast in saga we process the departure journey to Kerung. The journey will be new experience for you and you are heading down valley over the high passes. Kerung is last city of Tibet-China before entering to Nepal from Rasuwagadhi border. Spent last night in Tibet with celebration. In morning, we will good bye to Tibetan Guide and drivers. Check in hotel at Kerung Meal: Breakfast, Lunch and Dinner

Day 15: Day 15: Kerung - Rasuwagadhi - Kathmandu (1300m), 190km, approx. 7hrs

Today is our last day of Kailash Mansarovar Journey to reach Kathmandu. After breakfast, transfer to Rasuwagadhi Border by bus within hour. Complete the Chinese custom exit and entry to Nepal, Take a jeep drive to Kathmandu within 6 hours. Stay overnight at Kathmandu.

Day 16: Day 16: Free and final departure

Morning take drive to Pashupatinath Temple Darshan (if time applicable) After breakfast, free morning and final airport transfer or extend your trip.

- 4 nights 5 star hotel in Kathmandu. (Twin share room).
- Pure vegetarian(breakfast, lunch and dinner) meal as per plan.(Lhasa and Sightsee we use Nepali Restaurant for Vegetarian Meal under supervision with our team.) Rest place we cook our self through our kitchen team and serve you.
- Necessary kailash yatra permits, Chinese visa, kailash entry tickets and applicable government taxes.
- Flight from Kathmandu Lhasa (one-way).
- 4 Star hotels in Lhasa & Darchen, 4 Star hotels in Sigatse, Kerung and Saga, very basic mud house in Mansarovar Lake and during kailash parikrama.
- Free kailash yatra duffel bag, down jacket and walking pole (to be refund after the yatra), Yatra bag as complementary.
- Professional, reliable, friendly and service oriented Nepali yatra leader fluent speak in English


and Hindi language and English speaking Tibetan guide in Tibet.

- Air condition luxury bus and support truck for carrying yatra bag, equipment, food and staff from Kerung and Lhasa
- Life saving Oxygen tank, mask-regulator support (for emergency) and first aid kit with high altitude sickness medicine.
- Daily health check by our train staff (Pulse Rage, Heart breath, Pressure, Oxygen Level)
- Yaks and yaks man for Derapuk for to carry baggage and kitchen kits.
- Travel insurance for Nepali staff only.
- Free yatra complete certificate.

- International flight fare
- Bar bills and Beverage
- Tip for staff
- Personal Travel insurance and Rescue Evacuation on the tour.

- Kailash Tour Rescue jeep incase needed if some one go back earlier than group
