Other trip highlights include the Khaling Weaving Center, school for the blind and the Kanglung College, called Sherubtse, which is currently the only University in Bhutan. The cultural tour to Bhutan will offer travelers an opportunity to interact with the local people, understand their culture, their traditions, religion, which are by far the best experiences culturally during the tour to any new place.

The cultural highlights manifesting best architectural and religious delights with historic significance in the major cities of Bhutan that include Paro, Thimpu and Punakha are the biggest cultural highlights during the tour. The Drukyel Dzong and Taktshang Monastery are wonders of Bhutan. The ride from one city to another, which include the traverse across Dochu La Pass cater the magnificence of nature during the tour.
